## Who reports on this indicator?

In Greater Lincolnshire, the County Council and the two unitary authorities (North Lincolnshire Council and North East Lincolnshire Council) are expected to report to central government on performance on local biodiversity annually.

The Nature Partnership supplies the data necessary to do this in our role coordinating the Local Sites system.

## Additional information

These figures only include Local Wildlife Sites (LWSs), candidate LWSs, Local Geological Sites (LGSs) and candidate LGSs, not Sites of Nature Conservation Importance (SNCIs) or Regionally Important Geological and Geomorphological Sites (RIGSs).

These figures are accurate at the end of the financial year 2017-18.

- Some sites overlap local authority boundaries. Where this occurs the site is included in the total for each. Combined totals for CLJPU, SELJSPC, Lincolnshire County and Greater Lincolnshire are calculated without duplication of these sites.
- Information on management should be no more than five years old, and evidence of positive management can be sent to the GLNP at any time.

## National guidance

Defra have published guidance on the collection of data on improved local biodiversity, namely collecting data for and reporting on Indicator 160-00.

The guidance note states that documented evidence of the positive conservation management status of Local Sites must be provided. This can include a site management plan; inclusion in management schemes; a relevant Biodiversity Action Plan; or landowner receipt of management guidance and advice.

This guidance also states that: *“Where an informed assessment has been made within the last five years and ... this assessment finds that no intervention or action is needed at present to conserve the features of a site ... this can score as positive management”*.
